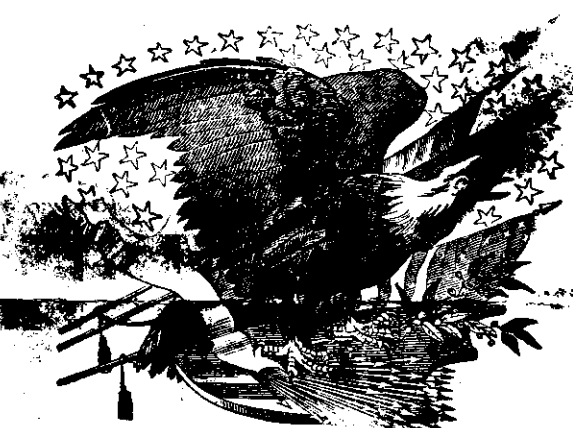


To all whom it may Concern
